- ❑ Pitch and Catch: a pattern of prophecy
 - ▶ the Flood—Methuselah to Noah
 - ▶ the Exodus—Abraham to Moses
 - ▶ the Captivity—Jeremiah/Isaiah to Daniel
 - ▶ Christ's earthly ministry (70 week prophecy)--Daniel to John the Baptist (more on this tomorrow morning)
 - ▶ Christ's heavenly ministry (2300 day prophecy)--Daniel to _____ (more on this tomorrow morning)
- ❑ Matthew 7:15; 1 Thessalonians 5:19-21; 1 John 4:1—While God calls us to be wary of false prophets, He does not want us to be ignorant of His true prophets.
- ❑ Biblical tests of a prophet include:
 - ▶ prophetic fulfillment: non-conditional predictions come true (Jer. 28:9)
 - ▶ should lead us to the Bible and _____ to God's Word (Isa. 8:19-20; Deut. 13:1-4)
 - ▶ exalts _____ (1 John 4:2)
 - ▶ Physical phenomena surrounding the gift (Dan. 10:17)
 - ▶ spiritual _____: demonstration of Christ-like character and productivity for God's kingdom (Matt. 7:15-17, 20)
