We ARE More than Conquerors (Romans 8:37)

- 1) **God gives the victory.** I Corinthians 15:57 (NKJV) “But thanks be to God who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.”
- 2) **Make no provision.** Romans 13:14 (NKJV) “But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to fulfill its lusts.” If God is giving you the victory, there is no need to keep any cigarettes/alcohol/magazines/_____ around in case you get tempted. Don’t plan to fail.
- 3) **God provides a way of escape.** I Corinthians 10:13 (NKJV) “No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.” God does not promise that no temptations to smoke/drink/lust/_____, but He does promise a way through those temptations.
- 4) **All things are possible with God.** Philippians 4:13 (NKJV) “I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.” That includes quitting whatever addiction you may be faced with.
- 5) **Ask in prayer.** Mark 11:24 (NKJV) “Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.” I trust God for the victory. I believe he has given it to me. It is then so.
- 6) **Have faith.** I John 5:4 (NKJV) “For whatever is born of God overcomes the world. And this is the victory that has overcome the world; our faith.”
- 7) **Believe.** I John 5:14-15 (NKJV) “Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him.
