



# WHAT ABOUT DINOSAURS?

A theory - Genesis 1:6-7 And God said, Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters, And God made the firmament, and divided the waters which were under the firmament from the waters which were above the firmament: and it was so.

Genesis 1:20 ...and fowl that they may fly above the earth in the open firmament of heaven.

Psalms 148:4 Praise him, ye heavens of heavens and ye waters that be above the heavens

Canopy of water overhead and water under the crust of the earth. Making the original creation was very different from what we see today. By causing a greenhouse effect, protecting the planet from harmful rays, and increasing the percentage of gases in the air.

## Evidence

"50% more oxygen than it does now." from air bubbles in amber (Time Magazine, Nov 9, 1987, p. 82) Some research shows it had 35% oxygen. (New Scientist March 11, 2000) "The only trend in the recent literature is the suggestion of far more oxygen in the early atmosphere than anyone imagined." (Thaxton (Ph.D. Chemistry), Bradley (Ph.D. Materials Science), Olsen (Ph.D. Geochemistry), The Mystery of Life's Origin, 1992, p. 80.)

New theory: Lack of oxygen not asteroid, killed dinosaurs. An 80-foot-long (24m) apatosaurus, also known as a brontosaurus, had a set of nostrils about the same size as a horse's... (International Falls, Minnesota News 1993)

Therefore there had to be a different atmosphere in the world for dinosaurs to live. What would this do for us?

Under double atmospheric pressure blood plasma will become oxygen saturated. Baby Jessica's leg and foot were saved because of a hyperbaric oxygen chamber.

England - over 600 multiple sclerosis patients are now being treated with hyperbaric oxygen

France- Very rewarding results are being demonstrated in the treatment of arthritis and vascular necrosis, cirrhosis and advanced liver disease,... plastic and cosmetic patients...

JAPAN- over 200 chambers, ... very promising work in treatment of sudden deafness and blindness.

SWEDEN- diabetic gangrene and burger's disease BELGIUM- re-implants of total extremities

INDIA- leprosy (hyperbaric1@earthlink.net or www.hyperbaric.com www.hochealth.com- they have a chamber in Vancouver, BC- \$50/hr, 877-520-6867)

"Patients who got extra oxygen were half as likely to be nauseated after surgery" (Lyons Daily News (KS) Jan. 20, 2000)

Many professional teams and players use hyperbaric chambers. Like Zack Thomas (Topps 2004 football trading card)

## **What about plant life?**

Dr. Kei Mori at Kao University in Tokyo raised tomato plants under a plastic greenhouse that filtered out UV light. It may be that he pressurized CO<sub>2</sub> to the stems of the plants. One 16 foot (4.9m) tall plant produced 907 tomatoes! Dr. Mori died in 1993, but his work continues today. It may be that the plants can still be purchased in the towns of Ohtama and Aki, Japan. Fossil cattails 60 feet long (18.3m) have been found in sedimentary rock.

## **What about insects?**

Today's bugs are limited in size by the amount of Oxygen and the air pressure. (Highlights for Children p. 8, May 2001)

Bugs growing in oxygen rich waters grow "up to 1000 times heavier than those living off Europe!" (BBC News Online Thursday May 1999)

Insect breathe through their skin so they can't get bigger because as an object gets larger it has less surface area (skin) compared to its volume. This is why huge insects can't breathe in today's atmosphere.

A 50 inch (1.27M) wingspan dragonfly fossil was found in Italy. (www.creationevidence.org)

Cockroaches over 18 inches (45 cm) long have been found in the fossil record! A fossil centipede 8.5 feet (2.6m) long has been found.

Fossils of grasshoppers over 2 feet long (60cm) have been found.

## **What about animals?**

Rhinoceros 18 feet (5.5M) tall (University of Nebraska Museum)

Giant Elk with 12 foot (3.7M) antlers lived on earth.

Fossil Buffalo horns have been found with a 12 foot span! (3.7m)

8 foot horn core is in Joe Taylor's museum. (www.mtblanco.com)

"A remarkable cache of prehistoric marsupial remains, including giant lions, 10ft-tall (3.4 M) kangaroos and a wombat the size of a Mini, has been unearthed in remote caves in the Australian outback. (Wombat the size of a Mini unearthed By Barbie Dutter in Sydney (Filed: 31/07/2002))

Giant sloths lived on earth before the flood!

Jaw of 7-8 foot beaver! (Found by Jim Erb 920-699-2516 in Johnson Creek, WS.)

SALAMANDERS OVER 6 (2m) FEET LONG

Sharks were 80+ feet (25M) long before the flood!

## What About Dinosaurs?

"The biggest pterosaur flying over the inland sea is Pteranodon. Like all reptiles, it grows throughout its life..." (Holt Earth Science, 1991, p. 293)

Giant Turtle is on display at Yale Museum, New Haven, Connecticut

The word "dinosaur" was invented by Sir Richard Owen in 1841. Before that time they were known as dragons. Even in 1891 the word dinosaur was still not in the American dictionary. Dragon in a 1946 dictionary 1. Now rare  
A huge serpent

Over 50,000 "ICA stones" have been found in Peru since 1961. Some with people and dinosaurs on them

Fossilized dinosaur skin found in Bolivia. Notice the rosette patterns. Now in Creation Evidences Museum, Glen Rose, TX

Dragons and Lions on the old walls of Babylon (The Rise of Babylon Charles Dyer p. 128)

Gilgamesh slaying a dragon (The Great Dinosaur Mystery by Paul Taylor p. 37)

"One Chinese legend tells of a famous Chinese man named Yu. After the great flood Yu surveyed the land of China and divided it into sections. He built channels to drain the water off to the sea and helped make the land livable again. Many snakes and dragons were driven from the marshlands when Yu created the new farmlands." (The Great Dinosaur Mystery. P. 42)

Marco Polo lived in China for 17 yrs. around 1271 A.D. and reported that the emperor raised dragons to pull his chariots in parades.

In 1611 the emperor appointed the post of a "Royal Dragon Feeder." Books even tell of Chinese families raising dragons to use their blood for medicines and highly prizing their eggs. (DeVisser, Marinus Willem, The Dragon in China & Japan, 1969.)

Why would the Chinese have 11 real animals and one "mythical" dragon? Beowulf slew many dragons and was killed while fighting a winged dragon in 583 A.D. at age 88! The story says Beowulf killed Grendel the dragon by pulling off one of its small front arms and the creature bled to death later.

## What does the Bible say about dinosaurs?

Behold now behemoth, which I made with thee; he eateth grass as an ox. (Job 40:15) Lo now, his strength is in his loins, and the force is in the navel of his belly. (Job 40:16)

Elephants, Hippopotamus, and brontosaurus or sauropod fit this description

He moveth his tail like a cedar: the sinews of his stones are wrapped together. (Job 40:17) But only the brontosaurus or sauropod fits this description

If they lived today where would they live? He (behemoth) lieth under the shady trees, in the covert of the reed, and fens (swamp) (Job 40:21)

The Likouala swamp in Congo and Zaire is 55,000 square miles. The state of Iowa is also 55,000 square miles. 24 foot (8m) crock killed in Congo 2005.

Is a Brontosaurus Roaming Africa's Wilds? (The New York Herald Feb. 13, 1910)

"The two suspected dinosaurians, Mokele-Mbembe and N'Goubou, are observed and encountered on a regular basis. ... I questioned an older Baka couple who work on Pierre's plantation... like most pigmies, they are very familiar with the flora and fauna of the region. I presented them with our book on known African animals and dinosaur illustrations. About 98% of our dinosaur illustrations were rejected, except for two which (they) picked out without hesitation they had observed... a sauropod dinosaur and a Triceratops." ## Giant humans?

A skeleton nine feet eight inches (2.95m) tall was recovered from a stone burial mound at Brewersville, Indiana in 1879. (Indianapolis News, November 10, 1975, quoted in Reader's Digest's Mysteries of the Unexplained Also call Renee and Peter Schissel @ 9985 W. 208th St. Lakeville MN 55044 612-469-4060)

A skeleton nearly ten feet long was found in the Humbolt Lake (NV) bed in June, 1931. (Lovelock Review-Miner's June 19, 1931)

A skeleton 12 feet tall was found by soldiers in Lompoc Rancho, California in 1883. The remains were reburied due to objections by local Indian. (The Unexplained by Dr. Karl Shuker p.151 For more on giant human remains, contact Todd Jurasek 918-481-1710 7311 S. Utia Apt 802, Tulsa, OK 74136)
