ا ا	Matthew 16:13-18—Jesus makes it very clear that He would build church upon the immovable foundation of Himself, the chief cornerstone (cf. Matt. 21:42-44; 1 Cor. 3:11 10:4; 1 Pet. 2:4-7).
	Ephesians 5:22-27—Paul paints the picture of Jesus loving and caring for His church just as a husband gives himself to one wife.
	The Bible is clear: there is "one Lord, one faith, one baptism" (Eph. 4:5). We have seen that Jesus established a single church, yet there are thousands of separate denominations within Christianity. What has happened? As we shall see, the book of Revelation gives us the answer.
۵	Rev. 12:1—There are women depicted in the book of Revelation. The first is a <u>pure</u> woman who represents God's church. (cf. Jer. 6:2; 2 Cor. 11:2) <i>More on this tomorrow.</i>
